LEARN THE ART OF GLASSBLOWING



Introduction to Glassblowing...
This class explores many basic techniques used in glassblowing. Students will learn how to safely operate different types of glass working equipment and use a variety of tools to manipulate molten glass. In this two-day class we will create many solid and blown glass objects such as marbles,



paperweights, pendants, jars, perfume bottles and ornaments. We will also experiment with many forms of glass such as dichroic, frit, and striking colors. This workshop concentrates on developing skills in basic glassblowing and provides a solid technical groundwork for future development. — \$250 No experience required.

Introduction to Bead Making...

In this two-day course students will learn everything necessary to create glass beads using a torch. The class will begin with a discussion of safety and proceed through studio setup and tools. Using borosilicate glass, students will learn the basics of shaping beads, pulling stringers,

applying color, as well as a variety of traditional glass working techniques. If you have ever wanted to try glassblowing or bead making this is a great class to start with. — \$250

No experience required.


